scene 1

in the field the Sunflowers are reviewing the history of the feud

SUNFLOWER 1 - Sunny

The sun sure is hot today, isn't it Sally?

SUNFLOWER 2 - Sally

Mmmm...I just love facing the sun!

SUNFLOWER 1 - Sunny

Better be careful your petals don't wilt!

SUNFLOWER 2 - Sally

Mind your own petals Sunny!

SUNFLOWER 3 - Suzie

Now, now, now, there is no reason to bicker!

SUNFLOWER 4 - Sammy

No reason to bicker!

SUNFLOWER 5 - Sandy

We hear enough bickering Suzie! It makes my leaves droop!

SUNFLOWER 3 - Suzie

You're not the only one with droopy leaves Sandy!

SUNFLOWER 4 - Sammy

My leaves are very droopy!

SUNFLOWER 4 - Sandy

All of our leaves look pretty droopy!

SUNFLOWER 6 - Stella

That's because we haven't been watered for days and days!

SUNFLOWER 7 - Shelia

My roots are absolutely parched Stella!

SUNFLOWER 6 - Stella

Well Shelia if they'd stop feuding with each other maybe they would start watering us!

SUNFLOWER 7 - Shelia

Wouldn't that be wonderful?

ALL SUNFLOWERS

"sigh"

scene 2

at the Van Gogh farm the family is complaining about their neighbors the Monets

PAPA VAN GOGH

looking out with binoculars

Those darn Monets have the curtains drawn - I can't see a thing Mama!

MAMA VAN GOGH

Well Papa they are up to no good if you ask me!

PAPA VAN GOGH

They've always been up to no good!

MAMA VAN GOGH

That's why we are feuding' with them, right?

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

Why ARE we feuding with them exactly?

COUSIN VAN GOGH

Gee GRAMMY I don't know. I figured you would remember!

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

Son, I'm so old I don't remember things like I used to.

COUSIN VAN GOGH

But you MUST remember what started the feud!

PAPA VAN GOGH

What started the feud? I'll tell you what started the feud!

MAMA VAN GOGH

They moved in and dug that silly old pond!

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

Filled it with the water we need to grow our sunflowers!

COUSIN VAN GOGH

Who would want silly old water lilies when you could have tall magnificent sunflowers?

ALL VAN GOGHS

in unison

The Monets!

scene 3

at the fence Tony is caught spying on the Monets by his friends

TONY VAN GOGH

looking out with binoculars

Gosh, I never realized how beautiful the Monet's garden was....

PABLO PICASSO

Tony Van Gogh! What are you doing?

EDGAR DEGAS

You're pretty brave to get this close to the fence that divides the land between your family and the Monets.

PABLO PICASSO

Edgar's right! Have you lost your mind?

EDGAR DEGAS

Wait a minute! I know that look...he hasn't lost his mind, he's lost his heart Pablo!

TONY VAN GOGH

What are you two talking about?

PABLO PICASSO

grabbing the binoculars from Tony

You're not admiring their beautiful garden.....

EDGAR DEGAS

grabbing the binoculars from Pablo

You're admiring their beautiful daughter!

TONY VAN GOGH

grabbing the binoculars from Edgar

Her name is Maria. And no I am not!

Tony starts to storm off but turns around

And what if I am?

PABLO & EDGAR shake their heads in disbelief and run after him

scene 4

in the pond the water lilies are reviewing the history of the feud

WATERLILY 1 - Wilma

I just love floating in our pond!

WATERLILY 2 - Wanda

Me too Wilma! But you ARE crowding me a bit...

WATERLILY 1 - Wilma

I'm crowding you? Maybe if your leaves weren't so large Wanda!

WATERLILY 2 - Wanda

My leaves are perfect! It's your lilly that's in the way!

WATERLILY 3 - Wendy

Ladies! Please! There is no need to have a spat!

WATERLILY 4 - Winnie

Wendy is right! All we do is listen to fighting between the Monets and the Van Goghs

WATERLILY 5 - Whitney

Those two families behave like a bunch of sticks in the mud!

WATERLILY 3 - Wendy

Speaking of mud, don't you think the pond is muddier than usual today Winnie?

WATERLILY 4 - Winnie

The water level does seem a little low. What do you think Whitney?

WATERLILY 5 - Whitney

The pond has been getting lower and lower for years now.

WATERLILY 6 - Waverly

That's because no one ever comes down here to take care of the pond anymore!

WATERLILY 7 - Winona

Waverly is right! All they focus on is feuding!

WATERLILY 6 - Waverly

Oh Winona, remember the good old days when Papa Monet would set up his easel on the bridge and paint me?

WATERLILY 7 - Winona

You? He was painting me, not you!

ALL WATER LILIES

everyone argues that THEY were the subject of the painting

scene 5

at the Monet Farm the family is complaining about their neighbors the Van Goghs

PAPA MONET

looking out with binoculars

Those sneaky Van Goghs! They've moved their house further away from ours! Again!

MAMA MONET

turning his binoculars around the other way

Papa, you're looking through the wrong end of these things again!

PAPA MONET

Whatever!. Wishful thinking I guess.

MAMA MONET

We will never stop feuding with those Van Goghs until they move away for good!

GRAMMY MONET

About that...why ARE we feuding with them exactly?

COUSIN MONET

Well because of all the terrible things they have done to us over the years GRAMMY!

GRAMMY MONET

Yes, yes, yes, I know that Cousin...but exactly WHAT terrible things?

COUSIN MONET

struggling to think of an example

Well there are just too many to mention GRAMMY!

PAPA MONET

I know why we are feuding! It's that field of Sunflowers!

MAMA MONET

Ever since they planted those horrid yellow stalks our pond has run dry!

GRAMMY MONET

Those darn tootin' plants have roots that suck up all OUR pond water!

COUSIN MONET

Who would choose a sunflower over a fragrant water lily?

ALL MONETS

in unison

The Van Goghs!

scene 6

at the fence Maria is caught spying on the Van Goghs by her friends

MARIA MONET

looking out through binoculars

Gosh, I don't think I've ever appreciated how magnificent the Van Gogh's sunflower field is....

FRIDA KAHLO

Maria Monet! What are you doing?

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

If your Papa catches you this close to the fence that divides the land between your family and the Van Goghs...

FRIDA KAHLO

Georgia is right! Have you gone mad?

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

Oh oh! I know that look....she HAS fallen mad Frida....madly in love!

MARIA MONET

Stop this nonsense talk!

FRIDA KAHLO

grabbing the binoculars from Maria

You're not appreciating the sunflower field....

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

grabbing the binoculars from Frida

You're appreciating the Sonny Van Gogh!

MARIA MONET

grabbing the binoculars Georgia

His name is Tony, not Sonny. And no I am not!

Maria starts to storm off but turns around

And what if I am?

FRIDA & GEORGIA shake their heads in disbelief and run after him

scene 7

in the field the sunflowers sense something is about to happen

SUNFLOWER 1 - Sunny

Has anyone else been paying attention to what's going on over at the fence?

SUNFLOWER 2 - Sally

I can't believe my petals!

SUNFLOWER 1 - Sunny

Tony seems to be spending a lot of time there...

SUNFLOWER 2 - Sally

With his binoculars!

SUNFLOWER 3 - Suzie

Maybe he is spying on what those Monets are up to?

SUNFLOWER 4 - Sandy

What ARE they up to?

SUNFLOWER 5 - Sandy

Up to no good if you ask me!

SUNFLOWER 3 - Suzie

I actually think he is only spying on ONE Monet.

SUNFLOWER 4 - Sandy

Just one?

SUNFLOWER 5 - Sandy

Probably Papa Monet! I have a very bad impression of him!

SUNFLOWER 6 - Stella

Frankly I think Tony has lost his mind.

SUNFLOWER 7 - Shelia

Well madness does run in the family.....

SUNFLOWER 6 - Stella

A Van Gogh has NEVER gotten along with a Monet!

SUNFLOWER 7 - Shelia

And rightly so! After all the Monets have caused us all sorts of trouble!

conflict song: BADLY FRAMED part one

scene 8

on the Van Gogh farm the family shares rumors they have heard about Tony at the fence

PAPA VAN GOGH

Have you seen my field of sunflowers?

MAMA VAN GOGH

They sure look droopy!

PAPA VAN GOGH

Those Monets! Stealing our water for their pond and leaving me with droopy sunflowers to paint!

MAMA VAN GOGH

Want me to get the cat after them again?

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

What is that cat going to do? Whiskers is not our secret weapon!

COUSIN VAN GOGH

grabs binoculars to look

Well SOMEONE is keeping secrets!

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

What are you talking about cousin?

COUSIN VAN GOGH

Oh my! Isn't that YOUR son?

PAPA VAN GOGH

grabs binoculars

It sure is!

MAMA VAN GOGH

grabs binoculars

What is he doing at the fence between our land and the Monet's?

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

I knew this day would come! The family secret is about to repeat itself!

scene 9

at the fence Tony is confronted by his friends for speaking to a Monet

TONY VAN GOGH

What are you guys doing here? Go away!

PABLO PICASSO

What are you doing here again?

EDGAR DEGAS

This is a dangerous dance you are pursuing!

PABLO PICASSO

You can't be serious about wanting to be friends with a Monet?

EDGAR DEGAS

He's not going to listen Pablo. It's like he only has one ear!

TONY VAN GOGH

That's my father Edgar! Besides, you can't just put people in boxes because of their last name Pablo.

PABLO PICASSO

I don't PUT people in boxes Tony, I just paint them that way.

EDGAR DEGAS

Yeah, it's called "cubism"!

TONY VAN GOGH

Shh! Here she comes! If you won't go away then just be quiet, okay?

scene 10

in the pond the water lilies sense something is about to happen

WATERLILY 1 - Wilma

Do you realize how long it has been since Papa Monet has brought his easel down to the pond to paint us?

WATERLILY 2 - Wanda

I heard he has been in the field painting those boring haystacks!

WATERLILY 1 - Wilma

Why would he choose to paint hay when there are so many more colors here in the garden?

WATERLILY 2 - Wanda

Have you seen his haystacks?

WATERLILY 3 - Wendy

Papa Monet must wear rose colored glasses!

WATERLILY 4 - Winnie

More like RAINBOW colored glasses!

WATERLILY 5 - Whitney

Well whatever glasses he is wearing they are making him blind to what is going on!

WATERLILY 3 - Wendy

What are you talking about?

WATERLILY 4 - Winnie

I know what she is talking about...haven't you noticed how much time Maria is spending at the fence between the two farms?

WATERLILY 5 - Whitney

Well, she doesn't like to come down to the pond because of the water rats!

WATERLILY 6 - Waverly

It's those Van Goghs that are the rats!

WATERLILY 7 - Winona

I thought for sure when we sent our rats over to scare them they would move!

WATERLILY 6 - Waverly

All that happened was our rat and their cat became the best of friends?!

WATERLILY 7 - Winona

But cats and rats can't be friends! Can they?

conflict song: BADLY FRAMED part two

scene 11

on the Monet farm the family shares rumors they have heard about Maria at the fence

PAPA MONET

looking through binoculars toward pond

It's getting worse! My pond is even lower than usual. And my water lilies are wilting!

MAMA MONET

That's because those Van Goghs are somehow stealing all our water for their sunflower fields.

PAPA MONET

looking through binoculars toward field

I know, I know! But what I don't know is why their sunflowers are so droopy..?

MAMA MONET

grabbing binoculars to look

That is very strange. They should be well watered with all of our missing pond water!

GRAMMY MONET

Has anyone seen my granddaughter Maria?

COUSIN MONET

If you're looking for her I'd check out the fence that divides our land from the Van Goghs...

GRAMMY MONET

Why? What in the world would she be doing there?

COUSIN MONET

I'm not sure, but I think she has been secretly talking to the Van Gogh boy.

PAPA MONET

That's absurd! No self respecting Monet would talk to a Van Gogh.

MAMA MONET

What sort of impression would that make?

GRAMMY MONET

I knew this day would come. The family secret is about to repeat itself.

COUSIN MONET

What secret? What secret?

scene 12

at the fence at the fence Maria is confronted by her friends for speaking to a Van Gogh

MARIA MONET

Why are you two following me? Go away!

FRIDA KAHLO

You are dreaming if you think there is anything to be gained by talking to a Van Gogh!

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

She's right Maria! I may be known as a modernist painter but your actions are WAY too modern even for me!

FRIDA KAHLO

You are only thinking of yourself!

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

This coming from the woman who is constantly painting portraits of herself.

MARIA MONET

You don't understand! Neither of you do! Tony is.....different!

FRIDA KAHLO

You have to snap out of this. It's like my work - it may look like a dream but you have to accept it as a reality!

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

What do you expect will come of you talking to him?

MARIA MONET

Shhh! Here he comes! If you won't leave then just please be quiet...and nice!

scene 13

in the field the sunflowers consider what life would have be like if there was no feud

SUNFLOWER 1 - Sunny

I am so thirsty.

SUNFLOWER 2 - Sally

Why hasn't anyone come out to water us?

SUNFLOWER 1 - Sunny

I don't remember the last time we were watered.

SUNFLOWER 2 - Sally

It's been days and days and days.

SUNFLOWER 3 - Suzie

It's because of their feud!

SUNFLOWER 4 - Sammy

Their feud is ALL they ever think about!

SUNFLOWER 5 - Sandy

They are so busy feuding they aren't paying attention to their chores!

SUNFLOWER 3 - Suzie

Wouldn't it be grand if they weren't always feuding?

SUNFLOWER 4 - Sammy

Keep dreaming!

SUNFLOWER 5 - Sandy

Wouldn't it be great if they watered us?

SUNFLOWER 6 - Stella

They didn't always feud you know....

SUNFLOWER 7 - Sheila

Really?

SUNFLOWER 6 - Stella

Sure! They're just so stubborn they've forgotten the truth of the past.

SUNFLOWER 7 - Sheila

The truth of the past? What is it?

ALL SUNFLOWERS

Tell us!

scene 14

on the Van Gogh farm the decision is made to stop Tony from speaking with the Monets

PAPA VAN GOGH

putting down the binoculars

I have seen enough! No son of mine is going to become friendly with a Monet!

MAMA VAN GOGH

Where are you going?

PAPA VAN GOGH

I am going to stop him from making a huge mistake!

MAMA VAN GOGH

All this fighting has me feeling like we have forgotten something.....

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

It's hard ot forget what you never knew!

COUSIN VAN GOGH

Grammy what are you talking about?

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

I'm just saying that maybe it runs in the family....

COUSIN VAN GOGH

What runs in the family?

PAPA VAN GOGH

I'll tell you what needs to run! Tony needs to run away from that Maria!

MAMA VAN GOGH

Now I remember! When was the last time anyone watered the sunflowers?

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

The two of you have been so angry at the Monets for stealing your water that you've totally forgotten to care for your seedlings!

COUSIN VAN GOGH

The only seedling that needs taking care of is one Tony Van Gogh!

storms off

PAPA & MAMA VAN GOGH

Wait for us!

both follow him

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

Hold on I can't walk that fast!

slowly follows after them

scene 15

at the fence Tony explains to his friends that the feud needs to end

TONY VAN GOGH

Look, this whole feud is a giant misunderstanding!

PABLO PICASSO

I think what YOU don't understand is how angry your Papa is going to be if he finds out you have been visiting with a

Monet!

EDGAR DEGAS

They are the whole reason why your family's sunflower field is so droopy!

PABLO PICASSO

They're a selfish family who only want your water for their waterlily pond!

EDGAR DEGAS

Hmmmm, that IS strange.

looks across fence

TONY VAN GOGH

What is?

PABLO PICASSO

What are you talking about Edgar?

EDGAR DEGAS

Well, if they ARE stealing the water from your sunflower field then what are they doing with it? Their lily pond is dry and muddy!

points over fence

TONY VAN GOGH

I told you! The Monets are not the reason the sunflowers aren't getting watered...The Van Goghs are!

scene 16

in the pond the water lilies consider what life would have be like if there was no feud

WATERLILY 1 - Wilma

What I wouldn't give to be floating in some clear cool water!

WATERLILY 2 - Wanda

My leaves are heavy with mud!

WATERLILY 1 - Wilma

It's been weeks since Papa Monet has come here to paint.

WATERLILY 2 - Wanda

He probably doesn't have enough brown paint on his palette!

WATERLILY 3 - Wendy

He hardly ever paints anymore.

WATERLILY 4 - Winnie

All he does is feud! That's what they ALL do!

WATERLILY 3 - Wendy

Remember when the whole family would come down here to the pond to pick water lilies and tend to the weeds?

WATERLILY 4 - Winnie

Those were the good old days.

WATERLILY 6 - Waverly

If they only remembered about the REALLY good, REALLY old days!

WATERLILY 7 - Winona

What are you talking about?

WATERLILY 6 - Waverly

They're just so stubborn they've forgotten the truth of the past.

WATERLILY 7 - Winona

The truth of the past? What is it?

ALL WATER LILLIES

Tell us!

scene 17

on the Monet farm the decision is made to stop Maria from speaking with the Van Goghs

PAPA MONET

putting down binoculars

I am not just going to stand here while my daughter is sneaking around with a Van Gogh!

MAMA MONET

Where are you going?

PAPA MONET

WE are going down to that fence for an intervention!

MAMA MONET

We haven't gone anywhere as a family since we started feuding!

GRAMMY MONET

We used to go the the lily pond all the time!

COUSIN MONET

That was before those Van Goghs stole our pond water for their sunflowers!

GRAMMY MONET

There was a time when the sunflowers grew right on the banks of the lily pond.

COUSIN MONET

REALLY? I find that hard to believe.

PAPA MONET

What's hard to believe is that Maria is becoming friendly with our family's enemy!

MAMA MONET

A Monet and a Van Gogh can't be friends!

GRAMMY MONET

Oh they can, and they did....but that's just water under the bridge...

COUSIN MONET

Huh? I thought the problem was that there WAS no water under the bridge?

PAPA MONET

Well? Are you coming with me?

storms off

MAMA MONET

Watch what you say Papa!

follows him

COUSIN

Yeah, you don't want to make a bad impression!

chases after them

GRAMMY

The past just keeps repeating itself....wait for me!

slowly following

scene 18

at the fence Maria explains to her friends that the feud needs to end

MARIA MONET

This whole feud between our families is based on ignorance!

FRIDA KAHLO

What I think YOU are ignorant of is how much trouble you will be in if your family finds out!

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

The Van Goghs are a selfish family who steal your pond water so their sunflowers can grow big and beautiful!

FRIDA KAHLO

Ummmm.....that IS very curious, don't you think?

point across fence

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

You would expect those sunflowers to be less droopy with all the water they are getting from the Monet's pond.

MARIA MONET

They aren't getting any POND water! They aren't getting ANY water!

FRIDA KAHLO

Well then where is all of the pond water going?

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

It's hard to see the pond through all of the weeds and mud choking the shoreline.

MARIA MONET

I told you! The Van Goghs aren't the reason the pond is low on water...the Monets are!

FRIDA & GEORGIA

Huh?

MARIA MONET

With all the feuding neither family has done any caretaking! All they've done is blame each other!

scene 19

at the fence the families meet to stop Tony and Maria but instead are convinced to end the feud

PABLO PICASSO

So no one has been stealing anyone's water?

EDGAR DEGAS

And we don't have any reason to hate the Monets?

TONY VAN GOGH

That's what I've been trying to tell you. Our families used to be friends.

MARIA MONET

But now they're so caught up in the feud, they can't see how similar we are.

FRIDA KAHLO

But will your parents ever believe you?

GEORGIA O'KEEFE

How are you going to get them to stop fighting?

TONY VAN GOGH

We're going to tell them the truth. That we don't have any reason to hate each other.

MARIA MONET

And that we should all just get along. We can paint a different picture for our future.

the Van Gogh family and the Monet family storm in

PAPA VAN GOGH

Ah ha! We caught you!

MAMA VAN GOGH

Tony Van Gogh, what do you think you're doing?

PAPA MONET

You've been caught red-handed!

MAMA MONET

Maria Monet, you are grounded for the rest of your life!

GRAMMY VAN GOGH

This is just like the last time.

COUSIN VAN GOGH

What do you mean last time?

GRAMPY MONET

I never thought I'd see a Monet and a Van Gogh working together again.

COUSIN MONET

Did you say AGAIN?

TONY VAN GOGH

The Monets aren't stealing our water for their pond.

MARIA MONET

And the Van Goghs aren't using our water for their sunflower field.

PAPA & MAMA & COUSIN VAN GOGH

What?

PAPA & MAMA & COUSIN MONET

Is that true?

PABLO & EDGAR

It is! Everybody has been fighting!

FRIDA & GEORGIA

And nobody has been farming!

VAN GOGH FAMILY

So it's our fault our sunflowers are droopy?

MONET FAMILY

And it's our fault our pond is muddy?

TONY VAN GOGH

But it doesn't have to be that way. The Monets and the Van Goghs used to work together.

MARIA MONET

They took care of the sunflowers and the water lilies together. And they painted side by side.

VAN GOGH FAMILY

When they're not muddy, your water lilies are quite colorful.

MONET FAMILY

And when they aren't droopy, we do like your sunflowers.

EVERYONE

Maybe we could help each other.

scene 20

at the fence the sunflowers & the water lilies reveal what happened to everyone once the feud ended

SUNFLOWER 1 - Sunny

The Monets and the Van Goghs tore down the fence between their farms.

SUNFLOWER 2 - Sally

They used the wood to build new easels.

SUNFLOWER 3 - Suzie

Papa Van Gogh and Papa Monet spend hours painting all over the farm.

SUNFLOWER 4 - Sammy

They're opening a new exhibit together soon.

SUNFLOWER 5 - Sandy

Their families are going to throw a huge party for them.

SUNFLOWER 6 - Stella

Maria and Tony and all of their friends paint together now too.

SUNFLOWER 7 - Shelia

Pablo has started giving lessons in cubism. But it's not everyone's style.

WATERLILY 1 - Wilma

Both families work together to take care of the farms now.

WATERLILY 2 - Wanda

The sunflowers get watered every day.

WATERLILY 3 - Wendy

And our pond is always full of clear, clean water.

WATERLILY 4 - Winnie

Now we're always in full bloom.

WATERLILY 5 - Whitney

Ready to be beautifully painted once again.

WATERLILY 6 - Waverly

Grammy and Grampy have started playing bridge together once a week.

WATERLILY 7 - Winona
