KAREN

Alright girls, here we go! I honestly have no time for this vacation but I already booked the boat so here we go.

KETH

Well maybe we shouldn't go. I would really rather be in school.

KAREN

You don't need to study all the time, Keth. You'll have fun.

KETH

But I'm going to miss out on so much math. So much science!

SAHARA

I want to be in the Bahamas already. I want a lobster. I want one now, Mommy.

KAREN

You can have anything you want, dear. As soon as we get there.

SAHARA

But please I want one now.

KAREN

(noticing a phone call) Sorry honey, I have to take this.

(to the phone) Karen Summers, CEO of Summer Flavors.

(listens) But the deal already went through- I signed for that last week.

SAHARA

(Wails and whines)

KETH

Shhh, she's busy.

KAREN

They gave the contract to Winter Smoothies?! But they are our rival company.

SAHARA

(Wails and whines)

KETH

Saraha, Mom's on the phone.

SAHARA

But I want a lobster.

KETH

I'll find you a snack. *(goes to find snack)*

SAHARA

(calling out to Keth) I want Mr. Snoogums Von Nuggets.

KAREN

Look- draft me up a new contract. I'll have it approved within the hour.

KETH

There you go. *(handing Sahara the bear)*

SAHARA

(receiving the bear from Keth) Mr. Snoogums!

KETH

(looking out over the sea) I'll admit it's actually beautiful out here.

SAHARA

It is pretty. And look- there's a dolphin!

KAREN

I'm glad you two are enjoying yourselves.

KETH

I still wish I could be in school.

KAREN

Think of all the animals and plants you can study when we get to the islands. It'll be very educational.

KETH

Yeah I guess that will be cool.

SAHARA

I like the dolphin. Mommy, I want a pet dolphin.

KAREN

(busy typing on her laptop, not listening) Of course honey, anything you want.

SCENE TWO: The Teens' Trip on a Ship

(The Summer Smoothies employees are docked and about to leave for the Bahamas)

PAISLEE

(filming herself) Hey everyone it's Paislee Nelson. Me and all the girls from Summer Flavors Smoothie Shop are going on a trip on a ship! Let's meet the crew.

HAZEL

Sup. I'm Hazel. I can't wait to catch some waves. I gotta get ripped so I'm ready for the rip currents.
(begins a workout)

ELLA

Ella here. And if you're into working out and getting toned you've got to check out my yoga gymnastics class. I'll be livestreaming from the boat later today.

PAISLEE

I cannot wait for tonight. We've got *the* Genevieve here live and in person. Genevieve what are you cooking up?

GENEVIEVE

I'm thinking something delicate, something sweet, a little pastry. The finest of French cooking.

LIZZIE

(dragging heavy luggage) A little help here?

HAZEL

I'll get it.

(Hazel grabs her bag and struggles with it)

LIZZIE

(fixing her hair for Paislee's phone) Ooh is this live?

HAZEL

(still struggling with the bag) Lizzie, what did you pack in here?

LIZZIE

All my clothes.

ELLA and GENEVIEVE

(looking at each other) ALL her clothes?!

LIZZIE

(to Paisley, Ella, Genevieve while taking Paisley's phone)

Yeah. Can you get the other bags?

(to the phone) I've got great new outfits for this trip with the shoes and nails to match. *(to her friends)* Come on people, can you move faster?

PAISLEE

(taking her phone back) Well it looks like we're packed and ready. Later fans!

ELLA

I'm really looking forward to this bonding experience together, everyone. It's so great to be out here in nature. The sun, the rolling waves.

HAZEL

The waves are going to be so sick. I cannot wait to surf. And play beach volleyball.

ELLA

Ooh I want to do beach yoga. With the sound of the tide and the sun setting. It's going to be so calming.

PAISLEE

I hope everything's not too calm- I could use a little drama to spice up my content.

GENEIEVE

Hmm, spices, yes. I want to find some new spices and recipes. I'm thinking Caribbean spiny lobster in a tomato and lemon soup.

PAISLEE, ELLA, HAZEL, LIZZIE

Ooooh.

GENEIEVE

I want to come up with a new recipe every day.

LIZZIE

I just hope there is a mall with mani pedis and shoes.

HAZEL and ELLA

Bahamas here we come!

PAISLEE

1, 2, 3

ELLA, GENEVIEVE, HAZEL, LIZZIE, PAISLEE

Girls' trip!

-THE STORM INTERLUDE PART ONE-

SAHARA

Oooh those dark clouds are so pretty!

KETH

I know what kind of clouds those are. Those are storm clouds. And now it's raining.

KAREN

I'm sure it's just a passing shower.

SAHARA

Mom, can you turn off the showers? Mr. Snoogums and I are getting wet.

KETH

There are worse clouds coming.

KAREN

Shh- not now honey. I'm trying to get this deal to go through.

KETH

Look out!

KETH, SAHARA, KAREN

Wooooah!

(the Summers family gets knocked out of their boat by a wave.)

-THE STORM INTERLUDE PART TWO-

ELLA, GENEVIEVE, HAZEL, LIZZIE, PAISLEY

Wooooah!

HAZEL

These waves are too gnarly!

LIZZIE

This is a disaster! These shoes can't get wet.

ELLA

Why would you bring shoes that can't get wet on a boat?

PAISLEY

My phone! It's soaked! Finally some good content is happening and I can't even film it!

GENEVIEVE

That's what you are worried about?! You are all being so dramatic.

HAZEL

I don't know if this boat can stand up to these waves.

ELLA

We will be ok. Keep calm everyone.

GENEVIEVE

Bleh! I just got so much seawater in my mouth. Too much salt!

PAISLEY

No! My phone!

LIZZIE

My shoes!

ELLA, GENEVIEVE, HAZEL, LIZZIE, PAISLEY

Aaaah!

(they are knocked out of the boat and swimming)

SCENE THREE: The Family Shipwrecked

KAREN

(out of breath) It's so hard to swim that far. Girls, are you ok?

SAHARA

Mommy, I hurt. My arms are tired. And Mr. Snoogums is wet.

KAREN

Your arms will feel better soon. You're a good swimmer. Now let me see your bear. Um, I'll just buy you a new one later.

SAHARA

Mr. Snoogums and I are wondering where we are.

KAREN

Definitely an island. I'm not sure where. But once we get Mommy's computer running we can find out.

KETH

We have to find food while there is still daylight.

SAHARA

That's boring. I don't like grocery shopping. I'm bored.

KAREN

Rice. Rice usually works. We need to find rice. Or... maybe sand will dry it out. (*begins putting sand into the computer*)

KETH

We need food and shelter. Let's go walk around and see what we can find.

SAHARA

The computer is broken. Just like Mr. Snoogums. Don't die on me, Mr. Snoogums! I need you!

KAREN

It's going to work- it has to. I need to send that email.

KETH

What is wrong with the two of you? We need to focus on survival.

SAHARA

I can't feel his heartbeat! Mr. Snoogums, stay with me!

KETH

Looks like I'm on my own.

KAREN, KETH, SAHARA

This is awful.

SCENE FOUR: The Teens Shipwrecked

GENEVIEVE

We're alive! We are all here! Wherever this is.

HAZEL

I have never seen waves like that. That was rough. You all swam so hard.

PAISLEY

I'm so glad we made it! Also that was like the worst thing ever. The only thing that could be worse would be if- *(checking for her phone)* My phone- my phone didn't make it.

LIZZIE

My shoes! Did you see them go in the wind?! My shoes are gone... forever.

ELLA

Oh Lizzie, I know they were your favorite. But we'll get you new ones someday just like them.

LIZZIE

No, I couldn't ask that of you. They were eight hundred dollars.

ELLA, GENEVIEVE, HAZEL, PAISLEY
EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS?!

LIZZIE

Why'd you think I cherish them so much? And they were really cute.

HAZEL

Ok that's ridiculous but we need to focus. What we need to worry about is how to find food and shelter.

ELLA

So true. Genevieve and Lizzy- see if you can find something to eat. Hopefully Genevieve will know if it's edible or not. Hazel and I will make a shelter for the night. Paisley- you start a fire.

GENEVIEVE, HAZEL, LIZZIE, PAISLEY

On it!

(Paisley sits and rubs rocks together as the others split up)

PAISLEY

Totally just rockin' out by myself.

GENEVIEVE

(walking back on with Lizzie) Aaaaand we're right back to where we started. Let's try this way.

ELLA

We found some branches! We can use these to lay on. *(setting the branches down)*

HAZEL

Wow, no way! My camping blanket washed up. *(shaking the blanket out and setting it down)*

ELLA

Even better! We are so lucky.

LIZZIE

(entering) You will not believe what I just did. I, Lizzie Rickley, climbed a tree. For coconuts!
(displays the coconut from behind her back)

PAISLEY

Oooh coconut water is really trendy.

LIZZIE

I know! Which is why I climbed the tree.

GENEVIEVE

We found mushrooms.

ELLA

It's not a lot but it's something.

GENEVIEVE

And my cooking pot washed ashore. So we can cook.

PAISLEY

I made a fire.

ELLA, GENEVIEVE, HAZEL, LIZZIE

Wow/How?/What?! (applauds)

PAISLEY

I've watched hours of survivalist youtube videos. So I'm basically an expert.

GENEVIEVE

I'm honestly so impressed with everyone. We might actually survive.

HAZEL

Yeah our teamwork is totally epic. If we keep this up we can do anything.

SCENE FIVE: Awake on the Beach

SAHARA

(waking up) Ewww! I have sand in my hair! There's a crab in here! *(smelling herself)* And I'm stinky.

KAREN

(waking up) Ugh my clothes are wet. *(yawning)* And I need coffee.

SAHARA

Where is Mr. Snoogums von Nuggets? *(walking around and calling out)* Snoogums? Mr. Snoogums?

KAREN

(panicking) Where is Keth?! Keth?

KETH

(entering) You're finally awake? I've been up for hours. I found fresh water. *(handing them water)*

KAREN

Where have you been? You could have gotten lost.

KETH

I've been finding food. I found edible seaweed, I caught a fish. I made sushi! *(revealing the sushi)*

SAHARA

(rushing over) Hungry! *(biting it)* Ewww! Yucky. *(hands it to Karen)*

KAREN

(hopeful) You found rice?! We can fix my computer! *(trying it)* Ugh- this awful. What is this?

KETH

It's not rice. It's coconut.

SAHARA

Snoogums? Snoogums where are you?

KETH

(pointing out to sea) I think he's there. Out in the water.

SAHARA

Can you go get Mr. Snoogums from the sea?

KETH

No, that's way too far out.

SAHARA

Mr. Snoogums! I will miss you. I've never loved anyone more. *(moving on)* Mom, I want my pet dolphin now.

KAREN

What are you talking about?

SAHARA

You said you would get me a pet dolphin.

KAREN

I said what?!

KETH

Mom, look- a bag washed up. Maybe there's supplies.

(Sahara, Karen, and Keth go through the bag finding clothes and accessories. They ooh and ahh over them and have a brief fashion show before arguing over who wears what.)

KETH

Wait! This bag washed up. Maybe someone else shipwrecked in the storm!

KAREN

Maybe we could find them. Maybe they have coffee.

SAHARA

Where are we going? Are we getting me a dolphin?

SCENE SIX: Island Living

(The teens are gathered sitting in a circle)

PAISLEY

And she found out that it was her brother all along!
(they all react and gasp at the end of this dramatic story)

GENEVIEVE

Great story Paisley. I'm going to juice some fruit for us.

HAZEL

I'm going to try to catch a fish. *(sits with a stick to fish)*

LIZZIE

I'll join you! *(sits beside her)*

ELLA

I think it's time for daily beach yoga.

PAISLEY

Oooh yeah, let's do it!

HAZEL

Wow! I did it! I caught a fish!

(Everyone rushes over to cheer Hazel and give her high fives)

GENEVIEVE

Bring it over here, Hazel. We can cook it up in my pot.

ELLA

You're all so amazing. Everyone, let's gather for our daily moment of gratitude.

GENEVIEVE

(serving juice) And let's have some juice! It's not quite like we make it at the smoothie shop. But it's certainly fresh!

ELLA

Thank you, Genevieve! Ok I'll go first. I am so grateful we all have each other.

PAISLEY

I'm glad we made it here in one piece on this beautiful island.

GENEVIEVE

I'm grateful we have fruit, water, fish, really everything we need.

HAZEL

I'm glad I actually know how to catch a fish!

LIZZIE

I'm glad that this is the outfit I got shipwrecked in. And that I still have great shoes in my closet at home.

PAISLEY

Aw, that was really cute, everyone. While the fish cooks, let's make a sandcastle!

ELLA

Yeah! I'll get sticks to decorate it with.

PAISLEY

I'll get branches.

HAZEL

I'll get vines.

GENEVIEVE

I found this rope.

LIZZIE

Wait- we should build a raft.

ELLA

Lizzie! You're a genius!

LIZZIE

I am?

HAZEL

Yeah! We could probably find enough materials to make a raft and float out of here.

LIZZIE

I am your survival queen. Bow to me.

PAISLEY

1, 2, 3

ELLA, GENEVIEVE, HAZEL, LIZZIE, PAISLEY

Survivors!

HAZEL

Look, there's something weird in the waves.

LIZZIE

Ew, it's a stuffed bear. It's disgusting.

GENEVIEVE

Maybe more of our stuff is washing up. Whose is this?

(everyone shrugs and looks around)

HAZEL

There must be someone else on the island. Maybe they got stranded too.

ELLA

We should go find them. Maybe we could help them.

PAISLEY

Oooh a rescue mission!

LIZZIE

Or maybe they could help us with the raft. Or maybe they found my shoes! Wait up!

SCENE SEVEN: Found

(The teens search for someone else on the island.)

GENEVIEVE

I wonder where they could be. The island seems so small.

HAZEL

Let's try this way. We have to keep looking.

(The teens exit as the family enters.)

KAREN

I am so sick of sand. And sun.

SAHARA

I don't want to walk anymore.

KETH

You are so annoying- will you quit complaining?

(The teens exit as the family enters.)

PAISLEY

It doesn't seem like anyone is around.

LIZZIE

Maybe we should give up. I don't want to get my clothes dirty.

ELLA

We can't give up! They might know a way off the island.

(The family enters.)

FAMILY

We'll never make it.

GENEVIEVE

HAZEL

And I caught a fish.

KETH

I did too!

ELLA

We have been working together as a team and helping each other out.

KAREN

Does anyone have a working computer? A cell phone? I need to send a work email.

PAISLEY

No, none of that made it.

SAHARA

Mr. Snoogums Von Nuggets didn't make it either. He went out to sea.

GENEIEVE

Is Mr. Snoogums this bear? *(holding up the bear)*

SAHARA

(taking the bear) Yes! Oh, Mr. Snoogums! I was all alone without you!

GENEIEVE

It looks to me like you were with your family.

KETH

She doesn't notice us much. She only cares about herself.

KAREN

Keth, be nice to your sister. And to these people. Maybe they will help us find some cell service.

PAISLEY

Is that what you are worried about? How can you even focus on that at a time like this.

LIZZIE

Paisley used to be obsessed with her phone and she's like totally fine without it.

KAREN

Well I am not fine. My business might be ruined.

HAZEL

That's what you are thinking about while you're stranded on an island?

PAISLEY

You know what? Life doesn't revolve around your electronics. Life is about family. And friends.

HAZEL

Yeah and having adventures with the people you care about.

GENEVIEVE

And spending time together as a community and sharing food.

ELLA

Don't get upset about what you lost. You need to focus on what you still have.

LIZZIE

Wow I think I really needed to hear that. Who needs shoes when I have you!

KAREN

(to Keth and Sahara)

I am so sorry, girls. You are what's really important.

SAHARA

I'm sorry too, Mommy.

HAZEL

(After an uncomfortable silence)

Sooooo... you wanna build a raft?

ALL

Yeah! Let's get out of here!
